After a series of questions, one gets attached, at times, to one idea or field. Excelling in that becomes the purpose. Therefore, we receive the award of excellent piece or work of art only by purpose-ful men/women. For example, Aryabhata's zero, Sushruta's Medicine Chanakya's statecraft was result of <sup>their</sup> understanding <sup>their</sup> one's purpose. Moreover, the search of meaning of

life has been always there. The inner world of our life too has received our attention. And hence, men asked - Who Am I, what is this Life for. Thus, to fulfil this purpose came many paths like Jnanyog, Bhaktiyog, Karmyog. One of them emphasised on 'knowledge' to know our purpose, the other on 'devotion' whereas idea of 'Karm' was to find purpose in our daily duties.

This brings us to question — How purpose is needed in our daily lives? For that we can ask what is life, first. Well, it cannot be explained in words, but for it means different to different people. Therefore, purpose is interpreted differently. For example,

for a hungry, the search is of food, for a father, the need is to sustain the family, for a mother, it is about welfare of the child and so on.

Furthermore, to set a purpose is also an art. While setting a goal like attaining 99% in the exam is not healthy, similarly imposing a purpose on others is also not useful. In recent time, we see cases of rising suicides. As per National Crime Records Bureau, more than 27% deaths occur due to failure in examination or unmet goals. (in India) And conditions become so severe, that students feel burdened. as depicted in the famous movie '3 Idiots'.



Taking the discussion from previous note, a purpose should be self-driven. For once, we have our own 'why'. We can bear any 'how'. See, the examples from the young lives of martyrs like Bhagat Singh, Khudiram Bose. They did not even care for their lives, for they were fully dedicated to an objective in life. Or when S.C. Bose said - Tumhe Mujhe Khoon Do Main Tumhe Azadi Dunga, he was in fact giving an end goal, a life of purpose to others.

Furthermore, without a purposeful life, we are not able to address so many problems around us. Paramhans Yogananda once said - 'What is the

benefit of mere existence. Millions are busy with just breakfast, lunch, dinner and getting entertained here and there. Instead, there is world full of needs, seeking us.

Take for example, the environment catastrophe is turning into Red Code Warning. The idea of Nationally Determined Contribution as pushed by UNFCCC (United Nations framework of Climate Change) gives a goal for nations. Young children like Greta Thunberg already found their calling.

Similarly, if the current generation does not set a purpose like Sustainable Development Goals, what could be the future of children? As per a UN report

by 2050, the world population will be 9 billion, and by the same time the crop yield would reduce by 40%. The purpose then, is to save humanity and for this many lives, many nations might have to follow same purpose.

In addition to that, the purpose of life, even though it may sound grandeur, can be very subtle also. For instance, Victor Frankl understood the purpose and meaning of life while he was in the Nazi Camps. For him, finding freedom of willpower is the real purpose. Isn't it the same idea

was given by Buddha when he asked us to live a life without suffering

by following Astang Maarg? The subtle idea is one can have many purposes. And one of them, could be the need to become a better human being.

As popularly depicted in a song —

'Kisi ke Vaaste Ho Tere Dil Mein  
Pyar, Kisi ka dard le sake,  
To leh udhaar, Jina Isi Ka  
Naam Hain'

(Jo have love for others, to take other's pain, this is life.)

Finally, the nation itself is a life. It runs on the lives of millions, millions of dreams and purpose. India for instance has now entered the Amrit Kaal of her independence. Soon, we would complete a century by 2047.



Thus, it becomes imperative to realign the purpose of nation with that of many aspirations.
