THE CORRECT APPROACH TO CSE

1. Know what to read and what not to:

As the syllabus for the Civil Service Examination is huge encompassing portions from basic school-level texts, it is at the very outset important to have a fair idea of what to read and what not to. Syllabus is the tool which tells you the areas that need to be covered for the examination and the basic rule for clearing the exam is stick to the syllabus.



2. Multiple Revision of Limited Resources:

Often aspirants surround themselves with 'N' number of books and study materials. What they fail to understand is that all these books and study materials relay the same facts and analysis, however in a different manner. Revising single source multiple times is always better than referring multiple sources for single topic.



3. Solve more questions:

Develop a habit of reading the daily newspaper and listening to daily news. The Hindu or the Indian Express can be selected according to availability and your level of comfort in reading the newspapers.

Our Weekly test series will evaluate your progress in a time bound manner and you will be made aware of your strong and weak areas by our experts.

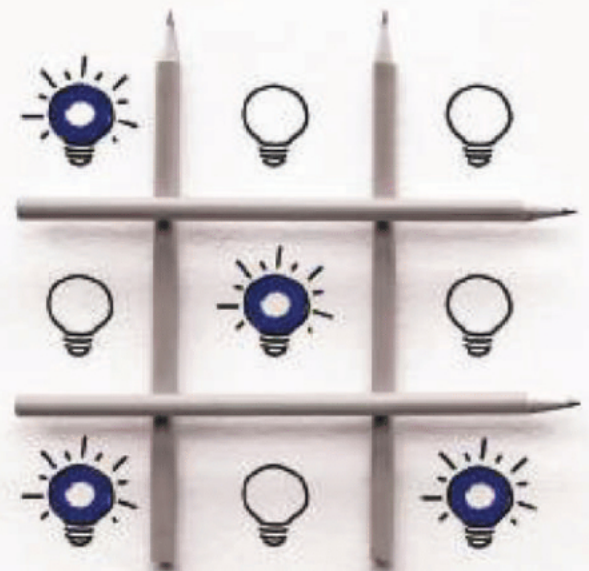
